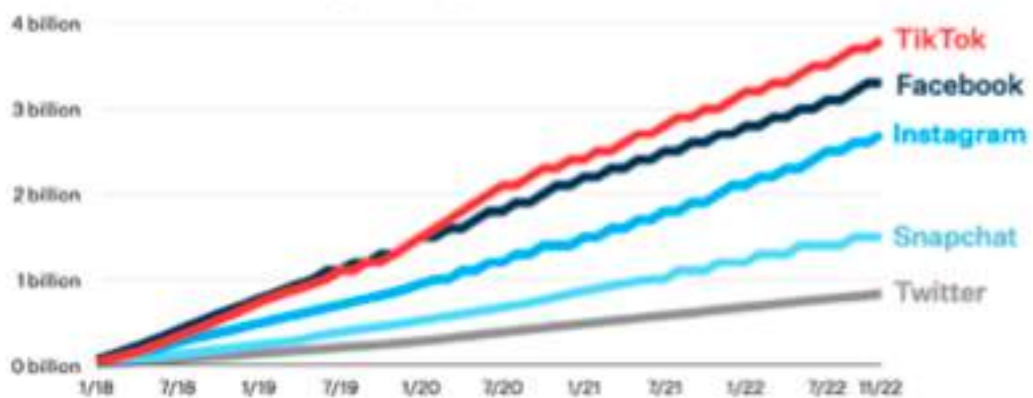

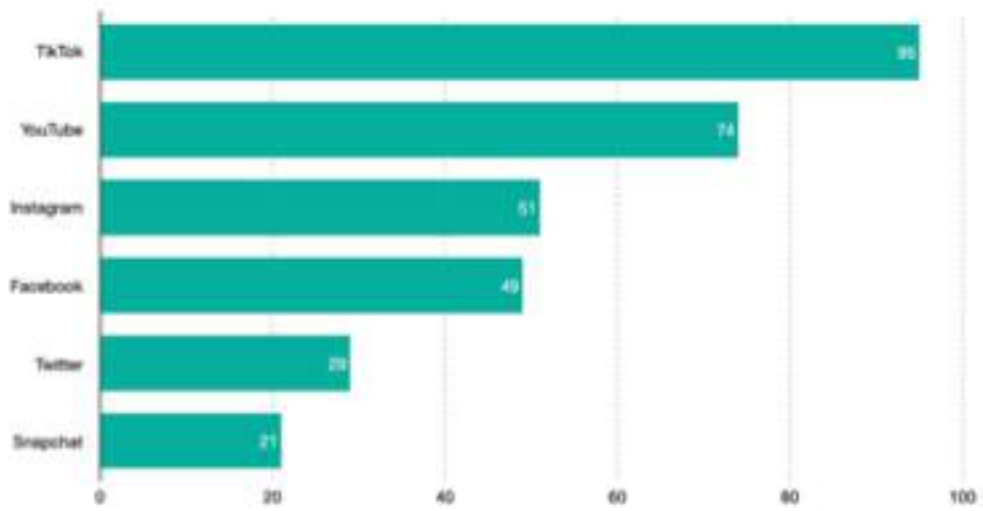
Estimated cumulative global downloads from Apple's iOS App Store and Google Play — Sensor Tower
